- Focus on delivering information as early as possible to the dog through timely handling and skill proficiency
- A holistic view of all the components required, including a solid mental game, fitness of handler and dog, and keeping all elements in balance.

4 October – Advanced Handling – 10am-3pm

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5 & 6 October - Masters & Beyond - 10am-3pm

Masters+ courses designed to push dogs and handlers out of their comfort zones, identify the best handling strategies for each team, plus a list of homework items.

7 October – Novice Handling – 10am-3pm

Getting ready to enter the ring with your next agility star? This session will help you problem solve your teamwork on novice-level sequences.

8 October - Young Dogs - 10am-3pm

Learn all the puzzle pieces to building a successful agility the start! This day will introduce many fun games you can play with your future agility star both without equipment and with the use of a few items such as tunnel and wings.

3 October - Contacts & Weaves (Training)- 6pm-9pm

This is for anyone just getting started, troubleshooting teaching weaves/contacts, or looking for ideas on how to make criteria clear from the very beginning. This session will cover start to finish teaching these obstacle skills.

4 October - Contacts & Weaves (Proofing) - 6pm-9pm

Do you have trained contacts/weaves, but want to take your skills to the next level? This session is for you! Challenge your pup's understanding, and get ideas on how to keep success high and develop a higher level of confidence in your dog's abilities. This session will focus on proofing already trained behaviours versus starting the obstacles from scratch.

5 October – Extreme Verbals – 6pm-9pm

Learn what all the top international handlers are saying! Open your eyes to what is possible for each verbal command, and leave with a game plan to teach them to your dog.

6 October - Missing Link - 6pm-9pm

Unlock Your Dog's Full Potential with this session. Do you have trouble motivating your dog at trials? Do trial environments send your canine partner over the top? Find out which pieces of the trial process are standing in the way of reaching your full potential as a team! We will dig into what makes your canine partner tick, how to work with their natural tendencies and build to create a driven, motivated and focused worker!

7 October - Extreme Blind Cross - 6pm-9pm

Think blinds only cue extension? Think again! Come learn the proper timing of blind crosses and see that when timed properly, they can be used just about anywhere on course.
